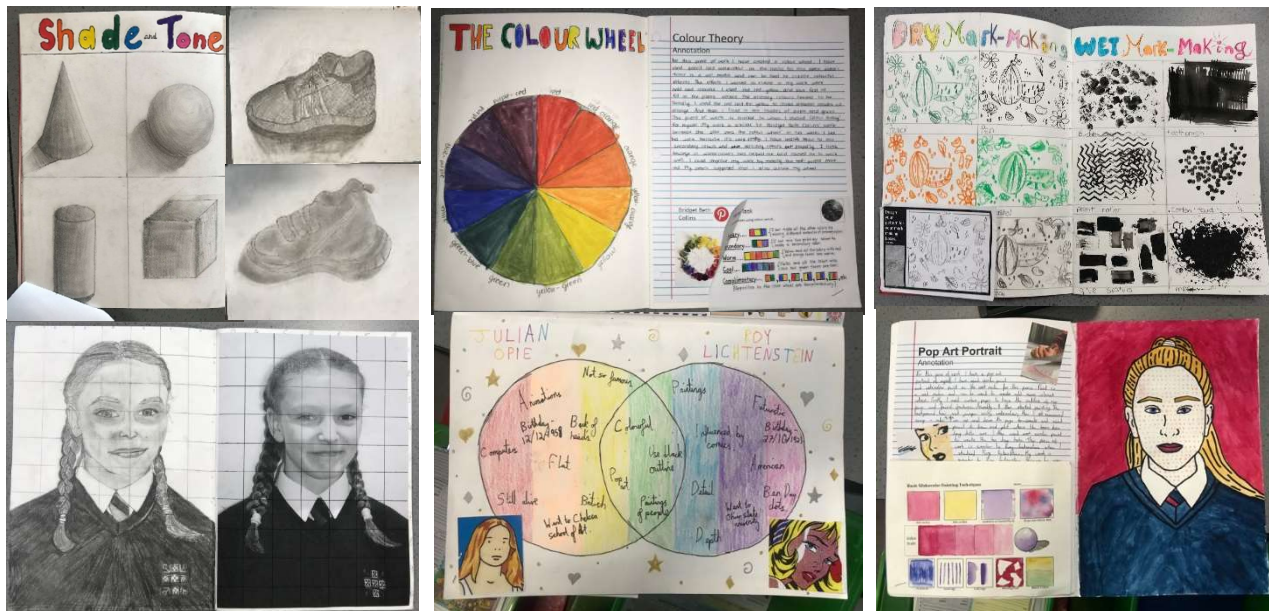


KS3: Art and Design

Learners in Year 7 and 8 spend two hours a fortnight, over two years, taking part in exciting workshops, using a range of wet and dry materials, to develop their basic and intermediate creative and written skills. The aim is to prepare learners for their GCSE studies with all the skills that learners develop in Art and Design being transferable to a range of GCSE subjects including Art, Craft and Design, Photography, Art Textiles, Product, Graphics and 3D design.

Year 7 spend the year studying the topic **Health: Healthy Eating** through the following tasks; Creative Name Page, Mark Making, Colour Theory, Shade and Tone, Observational Drawing: Pencil, Observational Drawing: Colour Pencil and finally Printmaking: Lino.

Year 8 spend the year studying **Character: Appearance** through the following tasks; Creative Name Page, Facial Feature Study, Gridded Self-Portrait, Artist Study, Pop Art Self-Portrait and finally a Clay Tile Portrait.
