We are also proud of the fact that 100% of our year 11 students achieved the Level 1 measure. This is the percentage of students that achieved 5 or more passes at A*-G and 90% of our students achieved 5A*-C grades which is a 23% improvement on the figure achieved in 2018. Furthermore, 81% of pupils achieved an A*-C in English, 72% in Science and 65% in Maths. These figures should ensure that the school is placed in the highest benchmarking category when compared to similar schools in Wales.
