Message from the Headteacher

Welcome to the first Major News edition of 2024! I trust you had a restful and enjoyable Christmas break.

In response to parent and pupil feedback, the canteen will be open at breaktime from Monday onwards. The menu has already been shared with you and is included later in the newsletter. Please be reminded that if your child purchases food at breaktime and wishes to also purchase food at lunchtime sufficient funds will need to be added to their account using ParentPay.

Unfortunately, we continue to experience issues on the school buses and pupils and parents have been frustrated this week that there have not been enough seats on the S36/38. I have spoken with the Local Authority about this and they have assured me that an additional bus will be provided from today. Representatives from school transport are also attending school when the buses depart today to monitor the situation. My priority, of course, remains ensuring all pupils get to and from school safely. There are still many young people presenting to buses without their passes, which slows bus departure down as they have to be checked and issued with a temporary pass. It would be much appreciated if you could remind your child that they need to have their bus pass with them every day. If they have lost it, please contact the Local Authority for a replacement.

We have had an increasing number of requests from parents/carers for pupils to be allowed to leave school early to catch the train home. I'm afraid that from a Health and Safety perspective we are unable to accommodate these requests and pupils need to remain in school until 3pm. Similarly, pupils will be recorded as late if they arrive to school after 8.30am due to catching the train.

I very much hope you have a relaxing weekend and thank you as ever for your continued support.

New Break time Menu, week commencing 15 January 2024

Our new break time canteen service starts next week. As a reminder the following options are available to all pupils during their morning break:

Mondays and Wednesdays:

Sausage wrap or baguette, hash-brown and omelette wrap or baguette, single large hash-brown, yoghurt, mixed fruit pots, bagels and tea-cakes.

Tuesdays and Thursdays:

Bacon wrap or baguette, hash-brown and omelette wrap or baguette, single large hash-brown, yoghurt, mixed fruit pots, bagels and tea-cakes.

Fridays:

Continental breakfast, pancake with honey, granola fruit and yoghurt pot, bagels and tea-cakes.

This is a new service, therefore we may need to tweak the menu or the provision over time, as we see how things work in practice. We will keep you updated with any changes.

ParentPay - School Meal Account Limit

As explained in last term's newsletter, we have introduced an 'overdraft' limit threshold on your child's lunchtime meal account.

This means that as soon as they are overdrawn by £5 they will only be allowed to purchase a main meal option (no cookies, cakes, multiple pizza slices or flavoured water) until payment is made and their account returns to credit.

No child will ever be denied a main meal, this cost will continue to be added to your ParentPay account, but we would remind you that you are responsible for any monies due on this account.

Once an account reaches the £5 overdraft we will send you a statement so that you can see the due balance and would ask that you then make a payment to bring it into credit.

If you would like to set a maximum daily limit your child can spend on meals we are able to facilitate this. Please email the school inbox with your child's name and the daily limit you wish to introduce. This will allow your child to purchase any combination of food they choose, but only up to the daily limit you set.

Please note that we can only change this once each term and it has to be entered manually, so please bear with us whilst we make the change and ensure that you have advised your child that you are doing this to avoid any embarrassment at the till.

If you do elect to set a daily limit, please bear in mind that any food selected at break time under our new break time food provision will count towards that limit and may prevent your child from accessing certain food at dinnertime if they overspend.

Chat Health

We might inform someone if we were concerned about your safety, but we would usually speak to you first. Your messages are stored and can be seen by other healthcare staff who follow the same confidentiality rules. We aim to reply to you within one working day and you should get an immediate message back to confirm we received your text. Texts will not be seen outside normal working hours. If you need help before you hear back from us, contact your GP, nearest walk in centre or dial 111. Our text number does not receive voice calls or MMS picture messages. We support messaging from UK mobile numbers only (which does not include messages sent from landlines, international mobile numbers and some 'number masking' mobile apps). To prevent the health professional from sending messages to you, text STOP to our number. Messages are charged at your usual rates.

Contacting School

Please refrain from telephoning the school, other than for urgent purposes. For all general enquiries please email llantwitmajorhs@valeofglamorgan.gov.uk. Please be reminded that we operate an appointments only system for meeting with parents and if you present at school requesting an immediate appointment we will not be able to accommodate you.

Forgotten Items

We can no longer accept the delivery of forgotten items such as PE kit, books, lunch boxes etc. during the school day. Please ensure your child arrives at school with the equipment needed for the day. In the exceptional case that you do need to bring an item into school for your child, you will be asked to leave it on the desk in the main entrance. This is to reduce traffic on to the school site and ensure student safety during lesson transitions.

Medication

Please note we **do not** stock medication of any kind in school, including paracetamol, and we are not allowed to dispense medication without parental consent. If your child receives prescribed medication a medical form, available from main Reception to be collected by your son/daughter, will be required to be completed and returned to Reception. Should your child need medication throughout the school day please ensure they bring just what is needed for the day to school with them.
